A RESOLUTION

Directing the Joint State Government Commission to conduct a 1 study and make recommendations concerning the development and 2 implementation of an integrated child welfare information 3 system for child welfare programs overseen by the Department 5 of Human Services and administered by county children and youth agencies. 6 7 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth's child welfare system is administered by the counties, each of which currently use one of 8 six different case management information systems and none of which allow for the sharing of information between counties; and 10 WHEREAS, The inability to share information through an 11 12 integrated system between counties creates a situation whereby patterns indicating abuse are less likely to be detected and 13 14 relevant information is less likely to be known, increasing the 15 likelihood that abusers will evade detection; and 16 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Department of Human Services, in 17 its 2014 Annual Child Abuse Report, indicated that it had implemented phase one of the Child Welfare Information Solution, 18 19 purporting to allow for the exchange of information across

- 1 counties and eliminating gaps in information throughout the life
- 2 of a case; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The United States Department of Health and Human
- 4 Services Administration for Children and Families, in 2016,
- 5 published regulations pertaining to the Comprehensive Child
- 6 Welfare Information System, which provided guidance, flexibility
- 7 and both technical and financial support for states that chose
- 8 to update and integrate their child welfare information systems;
- 9 and
- 10 WHEREAS, Years after it was first identified as a priority,
- 11 Pennsylvania still does not have a system that allows for the
- 12 sharing of information between counties; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Department of Human Services has been unable to
- 14 provide specific information about past or anticipated progress
- 15 on the project; therefore be it
- 16 RESOLVED, That the Joint State Government Commission conduct
- 17 a study of and report on the status of this project; and be it
- 18 further
- 19 RESOLVED, That the report shall include:
- 20 (1) A detailed summary of expenditures and progress.
- 21 (2) A projected timeline for the project.
- 22 (3) Identification of available resources including
- 23 those available through the United States Department of
- Health and Human Services Administration for Children and
- 25 Families.
- 26 (4) Projected costs.
- 27 (5) Recommendations on legislative action that may
- 28 assist the Department of Human Services or otherwise expedite
- 29 the process of developing and implementing an integrated
- 30 statewide child welfare case management system in the

- 1 Commonwealth;
- 2 and be it further
- 3 RESOLVED, That the report be submitted to the House Children
- 4 and Youth Committee and the House Appropriations Committee
- 5 within six months of the adoption of this resolution.
