A RESOLUTION

Designating the week of May 3 through 9, 2015, as "Children's 1 Mental Health Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania. 2 3 WHEREAS, Addressing the complex mental health needs of children, youths and families today is fundamental to the future 4 5 of our Commonwealth; and 6 WHEREAS, Developing comprehensive, coordinated mental health 7 services for children, youths and families is a critical 8 responsibility of State government; and 9 WHEREAS, It is appropriate that we set aside one week each 10 year to direct our attention to our children's mental health and 11 well-being and our system of related resources and services; 12 therefore be it RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the 13 week of May 3 through 9, 2015, as "Children's Mental Health 14

1 Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it further

2 RESOLVED, That all residents, agencies and organizations 3 interested in meeting every child's mental health needs unite in 4 this observance and in addressing the fundamental necessity of a 5 comprehensive year-round mental health program for children, 6 youths and families.
