A RESOLUTION

- Directing the Joint State Government Commission to study the 1 effectiveness of the Department of Education's Office for 2 Dispute Resolution. 3 WHEREAS, A free and appropriate education is available to all 4 5 children with disabilities in this Commonwealth; and 6 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth maintains procedures in accordance with Federal law to ensure that children with disabilities and 7 their parents are quaranteed procedural safequards with respect 8 to the provision of a free and appropriate education; and 10 WHEREAS, The Department of Education established the Office 11 for Dispute Resolution to provide due process for students with 12 disabilities and their parents who believe their school district is not providing the student with a free and appropriate 13 14 education; and WHEREAS, Parents who believe that their child is not

- 16 receiving a free and appropriate education and who are unable to
- agree to a resolution with the school district may request a due 17
- process hearing through the Office for Dispute Resolution; and 18

- 1 WHEREAS, At the due process hearing, a neutral hearing
- 2 officer will hear testimony and examine evidence from both the
- 3 parents and the school district; and
- 4 WHEREAS, At the conclusion of the due process hearing, the
- 5 hearing officer will issue a written decision, which is a
- 6 legally enforceable document specifying the legal obligations of
- 7 all parties; and
- 8 WHEREAS, If the parents or school district disagree with the
- 9 decision of the hearing officer, the decision may be appealed in
- 10 either Federal or State court; therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the Joint
- 12 State Government Commission to study the effectiveness of the
- 13 Department of Education's Office for Dispute Resolution; and be
- 14 it further
- 15 RESOLVED, That the study include all of the following:
- 16 (1) The number of hearing officer decisions that were
- appealed to either a Federal or State court.
- 18 (2) The final verdict of any hearing officer decision
- 19 appealed to a Federal or State court.
- 20 (3) The process by which other states provide due
- 21 process for students with disabilities as required by the
- 22 Federal Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.
- 23 (4) The litigation costs to school districts, including
- 24 attorney fees and compensatory education, of all due process
- 25 hearings.
- 26 (5) The litigation costs to school districts, including
- 27 attorney fees and compensatory education, of all hearing
- officer decisions appealed to either a Federal or State
- 29 court;
- 30 and be it further

- 1 RESOLVED, That the Joint State Government Commission issue a
- 2 report with its findings to the General Assembly within 12
- 3 months of the adoption of this resolution.
