- 1 Recognizing March 18, 2025, as "Public Defender Day" in Pennsylvania.

- 3 WHEREAS, March 18, 2025, marks the 62nd anniversary of the
- 4 United States Supreme Court decision in Gideon v. Wainwright;
- 5 and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Court unanimously ruled that the Sixth Amendment
- 7 to the Constitution of the United States guarantees the right to
- 8 legal counsel as a fundamental right essential to a fair trial,
- 9 and counsel must be provided to individuals who cannot afford to
- 10 hire an attorney themselves; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The ruling spurred nationwide efforts to recruit and
- 12 train legal defense attorneys for the purpose of providing a
- 13 public defense; and
- 14 WHEREAS, These efforts were built on Clara Shortridge Foltz's
- 15 legacy, who first presented her vision for public defense in
- 16 1893; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Public defenders fight to protect the liberty of
- 2 those at their most desperate, vulnerable moments; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Without zealous advocates, we cannot ensure that
- 4 people's rights are protected and that the innocent will not go
- 5 to prison; and
- 6 WHEREAS, In order to best serve this purpose, public
- 7 defenders must be recognized as an indispensable component of
- 8 the adversarial system and have access to the same resources as
- 9 the prosecution; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The lack of resources strains even the best-
- 11 attorneys and negatively impacts the quality of a legal defense,

- 12 jeopardizing the integrity of the criminal legal system; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania ranks 45th in indigent defense funding,
- 14 with per capita spending far below the national average; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Additional State funding is necessary to alleviate
- 16 the strain placed on public defenders and ensure that we uphold
- 17 Pennsylvania's Sixth Amendment protections; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Despite ongoing challenges, public defenders
- 19 continue to show up and give their all to their clients;
- 20 therefore be it
- 21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize March
- 22 18, 2025, as "Public Defender Day" in Pennsylvania and honor the
- 23 hard and selfless work of public defenders across this
- 24 Commonwealth.
