A RESOLUTION

Designating March 22, 2017, as "March for Meals Day" in 1 Pennsylvania. 2 3 WHEREAS, Hunger among senior citizens in America is a serious and pervasive problem, with one in six seniors threatened by 4 5 hunger; and 6 WHEREAS, Research indicates that 10.2 million seniors across 7 the country, and nearly 320,000 seniors in Pennsylvania, face 8 the threat of hunger; and 9 WHEREAS, Currently, 15.7 million seniors across the country, 10 and nearly 740,000 seniors in Pennsylvania, are isolated and 11 living alone; and 12 WHEREAS, Currently, 18.7 million seniors across the country, 13 and nearly 812,000 seniors in Pennsylvania, have difficulty

14 paying for basic living needs; and

1 WHEREAS, The senior population in the United States, and in 2 this Commonwealth, is projected to double by 2050; and 3 WHEREAS, The Meals on Wheels Association of America (MOWAA) 4 annually sponsors the March for Meals campaign, which is 5 designed to raise awareness of senior hunger and encourage 6 action at the local level; and

7 WHEREAS, Senior nutrition programs across the United States 8 promote March for Meals in their communities through public 9 events, volunteer recruitment efforts, partnerships with local 10 businesses and fundraising initiatives; and

11 WHEREAS, MOWAA is the oldest and largest national 12 organization supporting the more than 5,000 community-based 13 programs across the country that are dedicated to addressing 14 senior isolation and hunger; and

WHEREAS, MOWAA coalesces the resources of the Federal and 15 16 state governments, local community organizations and businesses, donors and 2 million volunteers into a national safety net for 17 18 Americans who are 60 years of age or older; and 19 WHEREAS, For millions of Americans, including more than 20 100,000 Pennsylvanians, MOWAA enables seniors to remain more healthy and independent, saving billions of dollars in health 21 care costs and allowing seniors to remain in their own homes 22 23 rather than relocating to a nursing facility; and 24 WHEREAS, An important goal of the 2010 March for Meals 25 campaign was to have Americans team up with their local Meals on 26 Wheels program and take a pledge to end senior hunger in the United States by 2020; and 27

28 WHEREAS, To achieve this mission, MOWAA has set a goal to 29 recruit 6 million people willing to pledge to do whatever is 30 necessary to end senior hunger; and
