A RESOLUTION

1 2 3 4	Designating the month of January 2013 as "Financial Aid Awareness Month" and commending the work of the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency and the Pennsylvania Association of Student Financial Aid Administrators.
5	WHEREAS, January is the first month in which students can
6	apply for financial aid to help finance their postsecondary
7	education; and
8	WHEREAS, The ability of some college students to attend and
9	pursue a postsecondary education is conditional on the
10	availability of student financial assistance; and
11	WHEREAS, Knowledge of the availability of student financial
12	aid to help finance a postsecondary education has been shown to
13	vary across demographic groupings; and
14	WHEREAS, The Commonwealth, through the Pennsylvania Higher
15	Education Assistance Agency (PHEAA), has been one of the leading
16	states in the nation, providing need-based State grant financial

assistance to eligible Pennsylvania residents and providing
other State financial assistance programs; and

3 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Association of Student Financial Aid Administrators (PASFAA) has been one of the leading State 4 associations of financial aid professionals in the nation who 5 advocate for access to postsecondary education and educate the 6 7 public on financial aid and funding opportunities; and 8 WHEREAS, The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is the first step in the financial aid process to apply for 9 Federal student aid, such as the Pell Grants, student loans and 10 11 college work-study programs; and

12 WHEREAS, FAFSA information is also used to award State grants 13 to Commonwealth students pursuing postsecondary education; and 14 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth, PHEAA and PASFAA want to promote 15 the availability of student financial assistance to help finance 16 a postsecondary education, in the form of Federal grants, State grants, loans, work-study programs and other specialized State 17 funding programs to help eligible Pennsylvanians pursue their 18 19 postsecondary endeavors; therefore be it

20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the 21 month of January 2013 as "Financial Aid Awareness Month," urge 22 all college students seeking financial assistance to apply for 23 financial aid through FAFSA and recognize the work of PHEAA and 24 PASFAA in their respective efforts to promote the availability 25 of postsecondary student financial assistance for the residents 26 of this Commonwealth.
