## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Amending House Rule 27, further providing for amendments.
- 2 RESOLVED, That House Rule 27 be amended to read:
- 3 RULE 27
- 4 Amendments
- 5 No bill shall be amended so as to change its original
- 6 purpose. (Constitution, Article III, Section 1).
- 7 No motion or proposition on a subject different from that
- 8 under consideration shall be admitted under color of amendment.
- 9 Any member may move to amend a bill or resolution, provided
- 10 the proposed amendment is germane to the subject. To determine
- 11 whether an amendment is germane, the question to be answered is
- 12 whether the amendment is relevant, appropriate and in a natural
- 13 and logical sequence to the subject matter of the original
- 14 proposal. To be germane, the amendment is required only to

- 1 relate to the same subject. The amendment may entirely change
- 2 the effect of or be in conflict with the spirit of the original
- 3 motion or measure and still be germane to the subject. An
- 4 <u>entirely new proposal may be substituted by amendment as long as</u>
- 5 it is germane to the main purpose of the original proposal.
- 6 Questions involving whether an amendment is germane to the
- 7 subject shall be decided by the House.
- No amendment to an amendment shall be admitted nor
- 9 considered.
- 10 The sponsor of an amendment shall explain the amendment prior
- 11 to consideration by the House.
- Before consideration, nine typewritten copies of a proposed
- 13 amendment signed by its sponsor shall be presented to the
- 14 Speaker, one copy of which shall be delivered to the news media
- 15 and a printed copy in typewritten form prepared by the
- 16 Legislative Reference Bureau shall be placed on the desk of each
- 17 member if the amendment is not available on the Legislative Data
- 18 Processing floor system.
- 19 Amendments adopted or defeated may not be considered again
- 20 without first reconsidering the vote.
