A RESOLUTION

- Designating calendar year 2019 as the "Year of the Student Journalist" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, A free press is essential to the support and
- 4 preservation of our freedoms; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Student journalists play a key role in the civic
- 6 life of their community; and
- WHEREAS, Student journalists report on important issues in
- 8 the life of a school or school district; and
- 9 WHEREAS, As the number of professional journalists has
- 10 dwindled, student journalists often also fill the gap in
- 11 reporting on State, county and regional issues; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The right to freedom of speech and freedom of the
- 13 press is guaranteed by the Constitution of the United States
- 14 and the Constitution of Pennsylvania for every resident of this
- 15 Commonwealth, including student journalists; and
- 16 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth's regulations pertaining to
- 17 student freedom of expression serve to further support and

- 1 protect the free speech rights of student journalists attending
- 2 public high schools; and
- 3 WHEREAS, It is highly important that student journalists are
- 4 free to exercise their Federal and State constitutional rights
- 5 to freedom of speech and freedom of the press; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Students across this nation have led efforts to
- 7 preserve and protect student press freedom, which has resulted
- 8 in the enactment of legislation in 14 states and pending
- 9 legislation in at least eight other states; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In 2014, a Pew research study found that student
- 11 journalists comprise 14% of the overall state House reporting
- 12 corps within this nation's 50 state capitol buildings; and
- 13 WHEREAS, 2019 marks the 50th anniversary of the 1969 United
- 14 States Supreme Court decision in Tinker v. Des Moines
- 15 Independent Community School District, which was a landmark
- 16 ruling defending the free press and free speech rights of
- 17 students; therefore be it
- 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
- 19 calendar year 2019 as the "Year of the Student Journalist" in
- 20 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor this
- 22 Commonwealth's high school, college and university student
- 23 journalists for their role in exercising, preserving and
- 24 protecting Federal and State constitutional rights to freedom of
- 25 speech and freedom of the press.
