A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing April 14, 2015, as "Architects Day" in Pennsylvania.

2 WHEREAS, It is important to recognize "Architects Day" to
3 remind the citizens of this Commonwealth of the unique
4 contributions architects have made to the history, texture and
5 quality of life in Pennsylvania; and

6 WHEREAS, The American Institute of Architects (AIA)
7 Pennsylvania, founded in 1909, is the Statewide component of the
8 American Institute of Architects; and

9 WHEREAS, AIA Pennsylvania has a Statewide membership of more
10 than 2,600; and

11 WHEREAS, The beginning of an organized architectural
12 profession in this nation was signified by the founding of the
13 American Institute of Architects more than 150 years ago; and

1 WHEREAS, Architects express the richness of our heritage and
2 the vitality of spirit through the vigilant stewardship of great
3 architectural and historic treasures; and

4 WHEREAS, Architects improve the quality of life for all
5 individuals in this Commonwealth by combining advances in
6 building technology with design innovation to build healthy,
7 safe, livable and sustainable buildings and communities; and

8 WHEREAS, AIA Pennsylvania and its members advocate good
9 community design and responsible stewardship of the built
10 environment; and

11 WHEREAS, AIA Pennsylvania and its members maintain the
12 highest standards of professional qualifications, ethics and
13 advancements in training and education; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize April
15 14, 2015, as "Architects Day" in Pennsylvania.
