- 3 WHEREAS, Margaret Thatcher, the longest serving Prime
- 4 Minister of the United Kingdom during the 20th century, passed
- 5 away on Monday, April 8, 2013; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Mrs. Thatcher was the first and only woman to serve
- 7 in the role of Prime Minister of the United Kingdom and the
- 8 first woman to lead a Western democracy; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Mrs. Thatcher was nicknamed the "Iron Lady" by a
- 10 Soviet journalist for her uncompromising politics and leadership
- 11 style; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Mrs. Thatcher is widely credited with reshaping
- 13 Britain's policies and transforming the country's economy; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Mrs. Thatcher's profound rejection of Communism

- 1 cemented a close relationship with President Ronald Reagan,
- 2 while still earning the respect of Mikhail S. Gorbachev; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Mrs. Thatcher will be accorded a ceremonial funeral
- 4 with military honors by her country; therefore be it
- 5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives memorialize
- 6 Margaret Thatcher as a great American friend and British patriot
- 7 and honor her enduring legacy.
