A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of November 13 through 17, 2023, as 1 "Pennsylvania Education for Students Experiencing 2 Homelessness Awareness Week" and November 15, 2023, as "Red 3
- Shirt Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 5 WHEREAS, In the 2022-2023 school year, 40,003 students in
- Pennsylvania schools were identified as without adequate 6
- 7 housing; and
- 8 WHEREAS, This represents a more than 20% increase from the
- 2020-2021 school year; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The purpose of this resolution is to educate the
- 11 public about the prevalence of students experiencing
- 12 homelessness, the barriers that may prevent youths from
- attending school and the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act 13
- (Public Law 100-77, 101 Stat. 482), which all schools must 14
- 15 comply with to overcome those barriers; and
- 16 WHEREAS, There are limited resources available to youths
- experiencing homelessness, including the shortage of affordable 17
- 18 housing for displaced minors; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Homeless assistance service providers, as well as
- 2 community service opportunities for students and school service
- 3 organizations need public support; and
- 4 WHEREAS, There are many organizations committed to sheltering
- 5 and providing support services, meals and food supplies to
- 6 people experiencing homelessness; and
- 7 WHEREAS, However, very few of these support services are
- 8 specific to the needs of unaccompanied minors; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Many shelters will not accept a child under 18 years
- 10 of age without the company of a parent or guardian; and
- 11 WHEREAS, There is still a dire need for additional resources
- 12 to assist students experiencing homelessness to attend school
- 13 and be successful, including the basic needs of food, clothing
- 14 and educational supplies; and
- 15 WHEREAS, To show Statewide solidarity with children
- 16 experiencing homelessness and their educators, the House of
- 17 Representatives encourages Pennsylvanians to wear red on
- 18 November 15, 2023, for "Red Shirt Day"; and
- 19 WHEREAS, The purpose of "Pennsylvania Education for Students
- 20 Experiencing Homelessness Awareness Week" is to encourage
- 21 schools, communities and individuals to plan for and support
- 22 assistance programs for youths experiencing homelessness as they
- 23 look to complete their education; therefore be it
- 24 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 25 week of November 13 through 17, 2023, as "Pennsylvania Education
- 26 for Students Experiencing Homelessness Awareness Week" and
- 27 November 15, 2023, as "Red Shirt Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it
- 28 further
- 29 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge all
- 30 residents of this Commonwealth to recognize that education is

- 1 key to preventing future homelessness and provides stability and
- 2 support to youths experiencing homelessness.
