- 1 Encouraging all residents of this Commonwealth to observe "Earth 2 Day" on April 22, 2015.
- 3 WHEREAS, April 22, 2015, is the 45th celebration of "Earth
- 4 Day"; and
- 5 WHEREAS, United States Senator Gaylord Nelson of Wisconsin
- 6 created the concept of "Earth Day" to encourage awareness for
- 7 environmental concerns; and
- 8 WHEREAS, It has been estimated that every year millions of
- 9 Americans participate in "Earth Day" activities to promote a
- 10 healthier and cleaner environment; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The importance of being good stewards of the
- 12 environment has become a nearly universal belief held by the
- 13 people of this country and this Commonwealth; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Protecting the environment is good for our health,

- 1 our economy and the plants and animals that inhabit this planet
- 2 with us; and
- 3 WHEREAS, "Earth Day" is a day to contribute to the well-being
- 4 of our planet; and
- 5 WHEREAS, "Earth Day" events and activities are designed to
- 6 promote environmentally friendly concepts, such as recycling,
- 7 energy efficiency, utilizing environmentally friendly products
- 8 and reducing pollution; and
- 9 WHEREAS, "Earth Day" 2015, with the theme "It's Our Turn to
