A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating the month of April 2015 as "Landscape Architecture Month" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Landscape architecture originated in ancient times,
4	specifically within the cultures of Persia, Egypt, Greece and
5	Rome, and subsisted with varying degrees of influence throughout
6	history to modern times; and
7	WHEREAS, In the mid-1800s, Frederick Law Olmsted, who is
8	considered the founder of American landscape architecture, first
9	rejected the name "landscape gardener" in favor of "landscape
10	architect"; and
11	WHEREAS, Olmsted is credited with establishing professional
12	standards and pioneering the concept that parks and outdoor
13	spaces should not only be well-designed, but serve as functional
14	green spaces, particularly within large congested urban areas;
15	and
16	WHEREAS, From the mid-1800s until the turn of the 20th

Century, the landscape architecture movement was born and
continued to flourish and influence the city beautification
movement; and

WHEREAS, During the Great Depression, the public works program began, at which time landscape architecture not only had a tremendous impact on urban planning and design, but more importantly on the design of national and state parks, local community projects and parkways; and

9 WHEREAS, For over a century, landscape architecture has 10 combined creativity, insight and expertise to enhance the beauty 11 of our Commonwealth; and

12 WHEREAS, Landscape architecture not only provides for the 13 design of parks, residential environments and other natural open 14 spaces, but also for the preservation of natural landscapes and 15 the conservation of historic landscapes; and

16 WHEREAS, Landscape architecture balances artistic and 17 scientific principals in planning, design and management of 18 natural and man-made environments; and

19 WHEREAS, Landscape architecture has made a tremendous 20 contribution to the quality of life of residents of this 21 Commonwealth; and

22 WHEREAS, The design of community centers, plazas and 23 streetscapes continue to rejuvenate communities throughout this 24 Commonwealth; therefore be it

25 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the 26 month of April 2015 as "Landscape Architecture Month" in 27 Pennsylvania.
