## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Urging the Congress of the United States to oppose the sale of United States Steel Corporation to Nippon Steel Corporation.
- 3 WHEREAS, Steel production is a vital piece of the United
- 4 States' economy and a critical element of national defense; and
- 5 WHEREAS, United States Steel Corporation (U.S. Steel) was
- 6 founded in 1901 by the merging of two steel companies and is
- 7 headquartered in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; and
- 8 WHEREAS, U.S. Steel produced the materials that built
- 9 skyscrapers, bridges, automobiles, appliances and thousands of
- 10 other products, helping to propel the United States to becoming
- 11 an economic superpower; and
- 12 WHEREAS, On December 18, 2023, U.S. Steel announced that the
- 13 corporation would be sold to Nippon Steel Corporation, Japan's
- 14 largest steelmaker; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The United Steelworkers opposes the sale of U.S.
- 16 Steel to this foreign company, as union jobs across this

- 1 Commonwealth could be at risk; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Nippon Steel Corporation's interests are tied to the
- 3 financial interests of its home country of Japan; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Domestic steel production is vital to the national
- 5 security of the United States, and administrations of all
- 6 political parties have sought to bolster the steel industry; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Nippon Steel Corporation has previously faced
- 8 health, safety, environmental and antidumping violations in the
- 9 United States; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The United States Treasury Department's Committee on
- 11 Foreign Investment in the United States is tasked with reviewing
- 12 the proposed sale of U.S. Steel because it involves foreign
- 13 investment in the United States; therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 15 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge the Congress of the United
- 16 States to oppose the sale of United States Steel Corporation to
- 17 Nippon Steel Corporation; and be it further
- 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 19 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania communicate this opposition to the
- 20 President of the United States; and be it further
- 21 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be transmitted to
- 22 the President of the United States, to the presiding officers of
- 23 each house of Congress and to each member of Congress from
- 24 Pennsylvania.
