A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of May 10 through 16, 2015, as "Women's Lung Health Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Every five minutes a woman in the United States is
- 4 told she has lung cancer; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Lung cancer is the number one cancer killer of women
- 6 in the United States; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The lung cancer death rate in women has almost
- 8 doubled over the past 37 years; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Advocacy and increased awareness will result in more
- 10 and better treatment for women with lung cancer and other lung
- 11 diseases and will ultimately save lives; and
- 12 WHEREAS, LUNG FORCE is the national movement led by the
- 13 American Lung Association, with the mission of eradicating lung

- 1 cancer by uniting women to stand together with a collective
- 2 strength and determination to lead the fight against lung cancer
- 3 and for lung health; therefore be it
- 4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 5 week of May 10 through 16, 2015, as "Women's Lung Health Week"
- 6 in Pennsylvania and encourage all residents of this Commonwealth
- 7 to learn more about the detection and treatment of lung cancer.
