- 1 Recognizing the 70th anniversary of the National Federation of
- Independent Business on May 20, 2013, and honoring the

- 5 WHEREAS, The National Federation of Independent Business
- 6 (NFIB), the leading small business association in the United
- 7 States, celebrates 70 years as the voice of small business
- 8 across the United States; and
- 9 WHEREAS, NFIB is the voice for 15,000 small businesses in
- 10 this Commonwealth; and
- 11 WHEREAS, NFIB was founded on May 20, 1943, as the brainchild
- 12 of C. Wilson Harder who believed that government should not
- 13 stand in the way of small business owners, but instead champion
- 14 their successes for the good of the nation and free enterprise;

- 2 WHEREAS, The positions of NFIB exclusively originate from the
- 3 democratic polling of its grassroots membership and reflect the
- 4 actual interests of small business owners; and
- 5 WHEREAS, As a result, the positions of NFIB lead to the
