- 1 Recognizing the month of May 2019 as "Foster Care Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The family, a primary source of love, identity,
- 4 self-esteem and support, is the very foundation of our
- 5 communities and this Commonwealth; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania House of Representatives is fully
- 7 committed to strengthening and supporting all families in this
- 8 Commonwealth; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Maintaining family unity is not always possible with
- 10 families in crisis and sometimes children must be placed in a
- 11 safe and nurturing family environment outside of their own home;

- 13 WHEREAS, In 2018, 25,441 children in this Commonwealth were
- 14 served by foster families who selflessly shared their homes and
- 15 their hearts with them; and

- 2 children and families heal and reconnect, and in preparing
- 3 children for successful adulthood; therefore be it
- 4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 5 month of May 2019 as "Foster Care Month" in Pennsylvania; and be
