A RESOLUTION

Urging the Congress of the United States to study and take action to ensure the effectiveness of the merger review 2 process and the Premerger Notification Program to foster fair 3 market competition and prevent anticompetitive, monopolistic 4 merges. 5 6 WHEREAS, A fair and competitive marketplace, free from 7 monopolies, strengthens our economy and insulates the public from damage caused when large companies and mergers fail; and 8 WHEREAS, In recent decades, the nation's economy has seen an 9 10 influx of high-profile and potentially troublesome mergers in a 11 variety of industries and sectors of the economy, including the 12 telecommunication, pharmaceutical, banking and insurance 13 industries; and 14 WHEREAS, The Premerger Notification Program was established under the Hart-Scott-Rodino Antitrust Improvements Act of 1976 15 16 to prevent large companies from substantially lessening market 17 competition or creating a monopoly; and WHEREAS, The Federal Trade Commission and the United States 18

Department of Justice review most of the proposed transactions

- 1 that affect commerce in the United States and are over a certain
- 2 size, and either agency can take legal action to block deals in
- 3 the interest of the economy; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Each year more than 95% of all acquisitions and
- 5 proposals are cleared during the initial review period; and
- 6 WHEREAS, A 15-day initial review period for cash tender and
- 7 bankruptcies is an insufficient amount of time to determine
- 8 anticompetitive effects of a merger; and
- 9 WHEREAS, A 30-day preliminary review period is an
- 10 insufficient amount of time to determine anticompetitive effects
- 11 of a merger; and
- 12 WHEREAS, In 2005, the Federal Trade Commission established
- 13 the Merger Process Task Force to assess and make recommendations
- 14 regarding the merger review process; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Significant reform to the merger review process has
- 16 not been made since the 2006 reform as a result of the Merger
- 17 Process Task Force; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Reform of the merger review process and the
- 19 Premerger Notification Program is necessary to adapt to current
- 20 legal standards and technology; and
- 21 WHEREAS, A system of accountability must be implemented to
- 22 ensure that mergers are not negatively impacting fair market
- 23 competition; therefore be it
- 24 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 25 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge the Congress of the United
- 26 States to study and take action to ensure the effectiveness of
- 27 the merger review process and the Premerger Notification Program
- 28 to foster fair market competition and prevent anticompetitive,
- 29 monopolistic merges; and be it further
- 30 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to

- 1 the presiding officers of each house of Congress and to each
- 2 member of the Pennsylvania Congressional Delegation.
