A RESOLUTION

1 Establishing, authorizing and empowering the Select Committee on
2 the Strategic Competition Between Pennsylvania and the
3 Chinese Communist Party to investigate, review and make
4 findings and recommendations concerning the status of the
5 Chinese Communist Party's economic, technological and
6 security progress and its competition with this Commonwealth.

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives establish,
8 authorize and empower the Select Committee on the Strategic
9 Competition Between Pennsylvania and the Chinese Communist Party
10 (hereinafter "CCP"), to investigate, review and make findings
11 and recommendations concerning the status of the CCP's economic,
12 technological and security progress and its competition with
13 this Commonwealth; and be it further

14 RESOLVED, That the select committee consist of six members of
15 the House of Representatives, including three members from the
16 majority party of the House of Representatives as selected by
17 the Majority Leader and three members from the minority party of
18 the House of Representatives as selected by the Minority Leader;
19 and be it further

1 RESOLVED, That the Majority Leader and the Minority Leader of
2 the House of Representatives each appoint a co-chair of the
3 select committee from among the members of the select committee;
4 and be it further

5 RESOLVED, That the select committee hold hearings, call
6 witnesses, take testimony and seek out additional resources to
7 complete the work of the select committee; and be it further

8 RESOLVED, That the select committee be authorized to sit
9 during the sessions of the House of Representatives; and be it
10 further

11 RESOLVED, That the expenses of the select committee
12 investigation be paid by the Chief Clerk from appropriation
13 accounts under the Chief Clerk's exclusive control and
14 jurisdiction upon a written request approved by the Speaker of
15 the House of Representatives, the Majority Leader of the House
16 of Representatives or the Minority Leader of the House of
17 Representatives; and be it further

18 RESOLVED, That the select committee be authorized to report
19 to the House of Representatives from time to time the results of
20 the investigation, together with such detailed findings, policy
21 recommendations and legislative proposals as it may deem
22 advisable; and be it further

23 RESOLVED, That the select committee make a final report of
24 its findings and any recommendations for remedial legislation or
25 other appropriate action to the House of Representatives on or
26 before December 31, 2023.
