A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the life and memory of the Honorable Thomas F. Lamb,
2 former Senator of Pennsylvania and member of the Pennsylvania
3 House of Representatives.

4 WHEREAS, Thomas F. Lamb was born in Pittsburgh October 22,
5 1922, to James and Agnes (Dunne) Lamb; and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. Lamb attended St. James Elementary and High
7 School and graduated from Duquesne University in 1948 and
8 Duquesne Law School in 1952; and

9 WHEREAS, He served as a Lieutenant in the United States Navy
10 during World War II from 1942 through 1946; and

11 WHEREAS, Mr. Lamb was elected to both chambers of the
12 Pennsylvania General Assembly, serving in the House of
13 Representatives from 1958 to 1966 and in the Senate between 1967
14 and 1974; and

1 WHEREAS, In addition to practicing law as a member of the
2 Allegheny County Bar Association for more than 50 years, he
3 served on the Board of Trustees of the University of Pittsburgh
4 and of the Robert Morris University and was vice chancellor of
5 Government Relations for the University of Pittsburgh from 1977
6 to 1985; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Lamb served as Secretary of Legislative Affairs
8 to the Governor between 1986 and 1991; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Lamb died May 7, 2015, at 92 years of age;
10 therefore be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the life
12 and memory of the Honorable Thomas F. Lamb, and extend
13 condolences to his family, friends and colleagues; and be it
14 further
