A RESOLUTION

1 Designating June 12, 2013, as "Home Matters Day" in this
2 Commonwealth to commemorate the home and recognize its
3 essential role as the foundation that nourishes, protects,
4 supports and encourages the lives and families in America.

5 WHEREAS, Home Matters was launched by the National
6 NeighborWorks Association on March 12, 2013; and

7 WHEREAS, Home Matters is funded by the National NeighborWorks
8 Association; and

9 WHEREAS, Home Matters illuminates the connection between
10 stable housing and important facets of American life; and

11 WHEREAS, A stable home contributes to individual success by
12 energizing adults and children for the day ahead; and

13 WHEREAS, A stable home encourages children to achieve a
14 successful education; and

15 WHEREAS, A stable home helps encourage healthy habits in
16 children and encourages adults to stay well and live better; and

17 WHEREAS, A stable home plays a role in the protection and
18 safety of American communities; and

1 WHEREAS, Having an affordable home allows individuals and
2 families of all income levels to spend more money, which helps
3 support and create a strong economy; therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate June
5 12, 2013, as "Home Matters Day" in this Commonwealth to
6 commemorate the home and recognize its power to nourish,
7 protect, support and encourage the lives and families in
8 America; and be it further
