A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the 100th anniversary of Ben Avon Heights Borough in
2 Allegheny County.

3 WHEREAS, Ben Avon Heights is a tight-knit suburban community
4 located on a hill above the Ohio River, nine miles from
5 Pittsburgh in Allegheny County; and

6 WHEREAS, Ben Avon Heights was founded in the early 20th
7 century by Walter Pringle Fraser and John Ibbotson Thompson; and

8 WHEREAS, The rural site of Ben Avon Heights attracted
9 Pittsburgh residents seeking a summer respite from the city; and

10 WHEREAS, Ben Avon Heights was incorporated as a borough in
11 1913; and

12 WHEREAS, Ben Avon Heights is celebrating its centennial
13 anniversary Friday, June 21 and Saturday, June 22; and

14 WHEREAS, The centennial celebration will include
15 architectural tours, a golf tournament, a fair and a family
16 picnic; therefore be it

1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
2 100th anniversary of Ben Avon Heights Borough in Allegheny
3 County.
