## A RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Directing the Joint State Government Commission to study the trend of grandfamilies in Pennsylvania and report its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly.
4	WHEREAS, Grandfamilies, or kinship families, are families in
5	which children reside with and are being raised by grandparents,
6	other extended family members and adults with whom they have a
7	close family-like relationship, including godparents and close
8	family friends; and
9	WHEREAS, In Pennsylvania, more than 195,000 children are
10	living with their grandparents; and
11	WHEREAS, More than 88,000 Pennsylvania grandparents are
12	householders responsible for their grandchildren who live with
13	them, and of these households nearly 29,000 do not have the
14	child's parents present in the home; and
15	WHEREAS, Nearly one-third of grandparents raising
16	grandchildren are 60 years of age or older, nearly 60% are in
17	the work force and nearly 20% are living in poverty; and

1 WHEREAS, For every child in foster care with relatives, there 2 are 20 children being raised in grandfamilies outside of the 3 foster care system; and

WHEREAS, Grandfamilies provide the State with significant savings by keeping children out of the foster care system; and WHEREAS, Forty percent of children in foster care with relatives are there because of parental drug or alcohol abuse; and

9 WHEREAS, Grandparents face unique emotional, legal, health 10 and economic challenges when they unexpectedly find themselves 11 in the position of raising a second family, yet they find little 12 support; therefore be it

13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the Joint 14 State Government Commission to submit a report on grandfamilies 15 that identifies:

16 (1) The number of children being raised in grandfamilies
17 from 2011 through 2016 and a comparison with the number of
18 children being placed in foster care.

19 (2) The average length of time children remain in20 grandfamilies.

(3) The reasons children are placed in the care ofgrandparents and great-grandparents.

23 (4) The impact parental drug or alcohol abuse has on24 children being raised in grandfamilies.

(5) The economic impact raising children has on
grandfamilies, including how it affects the earning ability
and retirement savings of grandparents.

(6) The impact of grandfamilies on the Commonwealth's
foster care system, including how much grandfamilies save the
Commonwealth in foster care costs.

(7) Emotional, social and legal challenges facing
 grandfamilies.

11 RESOLVED, That the report include recommendations on how to 12 connect grandfamilies with services and information, including 13 the creation of a Statewide website within an appropriate State 14 agency; and be it further
