- 1 Congratulating The Pennsylvania State University Field Hockey 2 Team on winning the 2016 Big Ten Championship on November 6,
- 3 2016.
- 4 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State University Field Hockey Team
- 5 defeated the University of Maryland 2-1, capturing a conference
- 6 record seventh Big Ten Championship title; and
- WHEREAS, Penn State's field hockey team's prior Big Ten
- 8 Championship titles were awarded in back-to-back seasons in 2011
- 9 and 2012; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Nittany Lions edged out the number-three-ranked
- 11 Terrapins, avenging their 5-4 regular season loss to Maryland;
- 12 and
- 13 WHEREAS, Down 1-0 at the half, the Nittany Lions controlled
- 14 the second half, as Gini Bramley, who was named tournament Most
- 15 Valuable Player, and Aurelia Meijer each netted a goal to

- 1 advance the Lions past the Terrapins; and
- 2 WHEREAS, During Big Ten action, Penn State went 6-2 and
- 3 finished second in the regular season before advancing to the
- 4 finals of the Big Ten Field Hockey Tournament; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The season was highlighted by eight victories over
- 6 ranked opponents and Penn State was top ranked on both sides of
- 7 the ball; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Penn State field hockey is ranked in the top five in
- 9 the nation in several categories, including win percentage at
- 10 0.895, scoring margin at 2.58, points per game at 11.16 and
- 11 penalty corners per game at 8.26; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Despite having a young team consisting of six
- 13 starters in either their freshman or sophomore seasons, Head
- 14 Coach Charlene Morett-Curtiss guided the Nittany Lions to a 17-3
- 15 record and a berth in the National Collegiate Athletic
- 16 Association tournament; and
- 17 WHEREAS, For their efforts, the Nittany Lions finished the
- 18 season ranked seventh in the national Ratings Percentage Index
- 19 standings and fifth in the final National Field Hockey Coaches
- 20 Association poll; and
- 21 WHEREAS, These rankings were Penn State's highest end-of-
- 22 season rankings since the team's historic national championship
- 23 game in 2007; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Hall of Fame Head Coach Charlene Morett-Curtiss has
- 25 been named the Big Ten Conference Coach of the Year six times,
- 26 including this season; and
- 27 WHEREAS, This victory was coach Morett-Curtiss' 500th career
- 28 win and her third Big Ten title; therefore be it
- 29 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives congratulate The
- 30 Pennsylvania State University Field Hockey Team on winning the

1 2016 Big Ten Championship on November 6, 2016.
