- 4 been ranked among the top 50 United States pediatric facilities
- 5 according to U.S. News & World Report; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Penn State Hershey Children's Hospital has earned a
- 7 national ranking in eight pediatric specialties in U.S. News &
- 8 World Report's 2015-2016 Best Children's Hospitals rankings; and
- 9 WHEREAS, This year marks the fifth consecutive year that Penn
- 10 State Hershey Children's Hospital has been recognized in
- 11 multiple pediatric specialities; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The eight pediatric specialties reflected in the
- 13 recent rankings are: cancer, cardiology and heart surgery,
- 14 gastroenterology and gastrointestinal surgery, nephrology,

- 1 neurology and neurosurgery, orthopedics, pulmonology and
- 2 urology; and
- 3 WHEREAS, U.S. News & World Report's rankings highlight the
- 4 top 50 pediatric facilities in the United States in each of ten
- 5 pediatric specialties; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Rankings are based on clinical data gathered from
- 7 184 pediatric centers nationwide; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Penn State Hershey Children's Hospital, located in
- 9 Hershey, Dauphin County, is a 475-bed general medical, surgical
- 10 and teaching facility; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Penn State Hershey Children's Hospital has attained
- 12 distinction as the sole regional children's hospital, Level 1
- 13 pediatric trauma center and Level IIIC neonatal intensive care
- 14 unit; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Pediatric medical and surgical specialists and
- 16 additional support professionals, including technicians,
- 17 researchers and administrators, provide comprehensive, leading-
- 18 edge patient care and family-centered care at Penn State Hershey
- 19 Children's Hospital; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Penn State Hershey Children's Hospital deserves
- 21 recognition for its exceptional standards of care for seriously
- 22 ill children and their families, its community outreach and its
- 23 continued achievements in medical education and research;
