A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating July 22, 2024, as "Hemihyperplasia Awareness Day" : Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Hemihyperplasia, also called hemihypertrophy, is a
4	congenital disorder, causing overgrowth of one side of a child
5	body in comparison with the other; and
6	WHEREAS, Hemihyperplasia may be isolated, occurring without
7	any signs or symptoms; and
8	WHEREAS, Hemihyperplasia may be a sign of another medical
9	condition such as:
10	(1) Klippel-Trenaunay syndrome.
11	(2) Beckwith-Wiedemann syndrome.
12	(3) Proteus syndrome.
13	(4) Neurofibromatosis Type I.
14	(5) Russell-Silver syndrome.
15	(6) Sotos syndrome;
16	and
17	WHEREAS, Symptoms vary depending on the child, but can
18	include difficulty eating, chewing, seeing and breathing; and

WHEREAS, Children with hemihyperplasia may have symptoms that
are difficult to diagnose; and

3 WHEREAS, The most common symptom is a subtle difference 4 between the two sides of the face and other appearance-related 5 concerns occurring as the disease progresses; and

6 WHEREAS, Treatment options include suction-assisted 7 lipectomy, excision of excessive skin and subcutaneous tissue 8 and contouring or reducing facial bones; and

9 WHEREAS, An orthopedic provider can provide treatment of 10 abnormal limb size to an individual suspected of having 11 hemihyperplasia; therefore be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate July 13 22, 2024, as "Hemihyperplasia Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania; 14 and be it further

15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives raise awareness 16 and encourage research to fight this disease.
