A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing August 31, 2017, as "International Overdose Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, "International Overdose Awareness Day" began in 2001
- 4 and has since been recognized by advocates, community
- 5 organizations, health care providers and government agencies
- 6 across the United States, the United Kingdom and Australia; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Participants of this global event aim to commemorate
- 8 individuals who have lost their lives to a drug overdose, raise
- 9 awareness that the tragedy of overdose death is preventable and
- 10 reduce the stigma of drug-related death; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The United Nations Office on Drug and Crime reports
- 12 that globally there are approximately 190,000 premature drug-
- 13 related deaths each year, the majority of which are attributable
- 14 to the use of opioids; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The United States accounts for approximately one-

- 1 quarter of the estimated number of drug-related deaths
- 2 worldwide, including overdose deaths, which continue to rise;
- 3 and
- 4 WHEREAS, Overdose deaths in the United States, which are
- 5 mostly driven by opioids, more than tripled during the period of
- 6 1999 through 2015, from 16,849 to 52,404 annually; and
- 7 WHEREAS, According to preliminary data compiled by the New
- 8 York Times, drug overdose deaths in 2016 most likely exceeded
- 9 59,000, marking it the largest annual increase ever recorded in
- 10 the United States; and
- 11 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth is in the midst of an
- 12 unprecedented epidemic of drug abuse and drug-related overdose
- 13 deaths, impacting every corner of the State and all of its
- 14 residents; and
- WHEREAS, In 2016, 4,642 drug-related overdose deaths were
- 16 reported by Pennsylvania coroners and medical examiners, an
- 17 increase of 37% from 2015; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Approximately 13 people died of a drug-related
- 19 overdose each day in 2016 in this Commonwealth, with thousands
- 20 more affected by addiction either personally or through family,
- 21 friends and loved ones; therefore be it
- 22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize August
- 23 31, 2017, as "International Overdose Awareness Day" in
- 24 Pennsylvania by joining in the global effort to support current
- 25 and former drug users along with family members who have lost
- 26 their loved ones to a drug overdose and encouraging discussion
- 27 about overdose prevention and drug policy.
