A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the 75th anniversary of the Pennsylvania Turnpike
- and the Turnpike's impact on this Commonwealth and on 2
- America's Interstate Highway System. 3
- 4 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Turnpike will celebrate 75 years of
- service in October 2015; and 5
- WHEREAS, The original 160-mile section of the Pennsylvania 6
- 7 Turnpike opened just after midnight on October 1, 1940,
- welcoming motorists to travel between Carlisle and Irwin; and 8
- WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Turnpike set the national standard 9
- for modern, limited-access highways and served as the model upon 10
- which America's Interstate Highway System was built; and 11
- 12 WHEREAS, The original 160-mile toll road that carried 2.7
- 13 million vehicles in its first full year of operation now spans
- 552 miles, carrying more than 194 million vehicles a year; and 14
- 15 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Turnpike is in the process of

- 1 rebuilding and widening the entire roadway from four lanes to
- 2 six to meet today's traffic demands and safety and design
- 3 standards; and
- 4 WHEREAS, More than 110 miles have been rebuilt and widened to
- 5 date and work continues as the Pennsylvania Turnpike remains
- 6 committed to putting its customers' safety first; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Turnpike, known as "America's First
- 8 Superhighway," forever changed the way Americans traveled and is
- 9 considered to be one of Pennsylvania's most treasured historic
- 10 assets; therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 12 75th anniversary of the Pennsylvania Turnpike and the Turnpike's
- 13 impact on this Commonwealth and on America's Interstate Highway
- 14 System.
