## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the month of June 2024 as "National Immigrant
- 2 Heritage Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, During this month, we honor the countless
- 4 contributions immigrants and their descendants have made and
- 5 continue to make to our shared communities; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Immigrants are a significant part of the United
- 7 States population and a crucial part of our nation's story; and
- 8 WHEREAS, While 5% of the total world population resides in
- 9 the United States, close to 20% of all global migrants reside in
- 10 the United States; and
- 11 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth was home to 939,000 immigrant
- 12 individuals in 2021, which made up 7.2% of this Commonwealth's
- 13 total population; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Immigrants built our country, heroically serve on
- 15 both military and health care frontlines, feed our communities
- 16 and spark economic growth and innovation; and
- 17 WHEREAS, While immigrants make up approximately 14% of the

- 1 United States population, they make up 18% of the labor force;
- 2 and
- 3 WHEREAS, Fifteen percent of health care workers, including
- 4 one-third of doctors in the United States, are immigrants; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Immigrants have also served in the armed forces of
- 6 the United States during every major conflict since the United
- 7 States was founded; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Additionally, nearly three-quarters of our farm
- 9 workers are immigrants; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Hundreds of thousands of immigrants performed the
- 11 essential work of packing, stocking and shipping goods
- 12 throughout this country during the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Immigrants own approximately one in five businesses,
- 14 and almost half of all Fortune 500 companies were started by
- 15 immigrants or their children; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Immigrants added \$2 trillion to the gross domestic
- 17 product of the United States in 2016 and \$458.7 billion to
- 18 Federal, State and local taxes in 2018; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Immigrants represent 16% of inventors in the United
- 20 States and have produced 23% of patents, patent citations and
- 21 the economic value of the patents; and
- 22 WHEREAS, Seven municipalities in this Commonwealth have
- 23 recognized the tremendous value that immigrants bring to their
- 24 communities by joining Welcoming America's global network of
- 25 nonprofit organizations and governments committed to being
- 26 welcoming places for all residents, including immigrants; and
- 27 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has a long way to go in
- 28 recognizing and encouraging the continued contributions of our
- 29 immigrant residents; and
- 30 WHEREAS, "National Immigrant Heritage Month" was started to

- 1 give "people across the United States an opportunity to annually
- 2 explore their own heritage and celebrate the shared diversity
- 3 that forms the unique story of America"; and
- 4 WHEREAS, This year marks the 11th anniversary of "National
- 5 Immigrant Heritage Month" in the United States; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Two Presidents of the United States, 48 states and
- 7 257 small towns and metropolitan areas across this country have
- 8 joined together to honor immigrants during the month of June;
- 9 therefore be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 11 month of June 2024 as "National Immigrant Heritage Month" in
- 12 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives celebrate this
- 14 Commonwealth's diversity and honor the important contributions
- 15 immigrants have made and continue to make in this Commonwealth.
