A RESOLUTION

1	Designating September 21, 2015, as "Peace Day" in Pennsylvania.
2	WHEREAS, September 21, 2015, marks the 31st anniversary of
3	the United Nations International Day of Peace, otherwise known
4	as "Peace Day"; and
5	WHEREAS, International Day of Peace was established by United
6	Nations Resolution 36/67, which was adopted unanimously on
7	November 30, 1981; and
8	WHEREAS, In 2001, the General Assembly of the United Nations
9	unanimously adopted resolution 55/282, which declared September
10	21 as an annual day of nonviolence and cease-fire; and
11	WHEREAS, The United Nations Association of Greater
12	Philadelphia established "Peace Day Philly" with cooperation
13	from a wide range of other groups in order to promote peace and
14	nonviolence; and
15	WHEREAS, "Peace Day Philly," which organizes "Peace Day"

activities in the City of Brotherly Love, annually involves
dozens of local and international organizations in building a
culture of peace; and

WHEREAS, This Commonwealth was founded as a haven for civil and religious freedom by Quakers and other immigrants who put their faith not in war, but in peaceful coexistence; and WHEREAS, With wars destroying lives and communities in nations near and far, peace could not be more desperately needed; and

10 WHEREAS, It is commendable that peace organizations promote 11 the United Nations "International Day of Peace"; therefore be it 12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate 13 September 21, 2015, as "Peace Day" in Pennsylvania.
