## A RESOLUTION

Honoring the service and sacrifice of our nation's Korean veterans of the Vietnam War.

WHEREAS, The United States entered the Vietnam War to prevent
a Communist takeover of South Vietnam and more than three
million American troops fought bravely in the cause of freedom and democracy; and

WHEREAS, 58,193 American soldiers were killed and more than 300,000 were wounded during the conflict; and

WHEREAS, Korean soldiers were sent to the Vietnam War to support American troops and the cause for freedom at the request of the United States; and

WHEREAS, 325,517 Korean soldiers served valiantly in Vietnam
from 1964 through 1973; and
WHEREAS, 5,099 Korean soldiers were killed and 10,962 Korean soldiers were injured during the war; and

WHEREAS, The Korean soldiers who fought heroically alongside American soldiers were known throughout the conflict for their effectiveness; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the significant and enduring accomplishments of our nation's Korean veterans and confirm its commitment to preserving the memory of those who made the ultimate sacrifice during the Vietnam War.
