A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the service and sacrifice of our nation's Korean 2 veterans of the Vietnam War.
- 3 WHEREAS, The United States entered the Vietnam War to prevent
- 4 a Communist takeover of South Vietnam and more than three
- 5 million American troops fought bravely in the cause of freedom
- 6 and democracy; and
- 7 WHEREAS, 58,193 American soldiers were killed and more than
- 8 300,000 were wounded during the conflict; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Korean soldiers were sent to the Vietnam War to
- 10 support American troops and the cause for freedom at the request
- 11 of the United States; and
- 12 WHEREAS, 325,517 Korean soldiers served valiantly in Vietnam

- 1 from 1964 through 1973; and
- WHEREAS, 5,099 Korean soldiers were killed and 10,962 Korean
- 3 soldiers were injured during the war; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The Korean soldiers who fought heroically alongside
- 5 American soldiers were known throughout the conflict for their
- 6 effectiveness; therefore be it
- 7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 8 significant and enduring accomplishments of our nation's Korean
- 9 veterans and confirm its commitment to preserving the memory of
- 10 those who made the ultimate sacrifice during the Vietnam War.
