A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing October 7, 2017, as "Trigeminal Neuralgia Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania. 2
- WHEREAS, Trigeminal neuralgia is a chronic pain condition 3
- characterized by episodes of intense pain in the face
- 5 originating from the trigeminal nerve; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The pain felt is the most excruciating known to man,
- 7 which is why it is called the "suicide disease"; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The condition is so rare that it only affects 1 in
- 20,000 individuals; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The number of those affected may be higher due to
- 11 misdiagnosis; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Women are more likely than men to be affected;
- 13 therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize October
- 7, 2017, as "Trigeminal Neuralgia Awareness Day" in 15
- Pennsylvania. 16
