A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing February 10, 2014, as the 60th anniversary of the addition of the words "under God" to the Pledge of Allegiance of the United States.
- 4 WHEREAS, The Founders of the United States of America
- 5 observed, in the Declaration of Independence, the self-evident
- 6 truth that rights of life and liberty are an endowment from our
- 7 Creator; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The people of this Commonwealth have affirmed, in
- 9 the Constitution of Pennsylvania, their belief in God and their
- 10 thanksqiving for His blessings of civil and religious liberty;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, On February 7, 1954, President Dwight D. Eisenhower
- 13 came to the conviction that adding the words "under God" to the
- 14 Pledge of Allegiance of the United States would be the right
- 15 thing to do after hearing Reverend George Docherty preach that
- 16 the phrase "nation under God," which was first used in the

- 1 Gettysburg Address, was appropriate to be added to the Pledge of
- 2 Allegiance because freedom "is defined by a fundamental belief
- 3 in God"; and
- WHEREAS, On February 10, 1954, Senator Homer Ferguson of
- 5 Michigan introduced a bill in the United States Senate to amend
- 6 the Pledge of Allegiance by adding the words "under God" to the
- 7 text of the pledge; and
- 8 WHEREAS, February 10, 1954, was chosen as the date to
- 9 introduce the bill by Senator Ferguson because it was TO
- 10 RECOGNIZE the fifth anniversary of the imprisonment of Cardinal

- 11 Joseph Mindszenty of Hungary, who was imprisoned and tortured by
- 12 Communists for his sermons exposing the goal of communism to
- 13 eradicate all religion; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Upon introduction of the bill, Senator Ferguson
- 15 commented, "Our nation is founded on a fundamental belief in
- 16 God, and the first and most important reason for the existence
- 17 of our government is to protect the God-given rights of our
- 18 citizens. Spiritual values are every bit as important to the
- 19 defense and safety of our nation as are military and economic
- 20 values"; and
- 21 WHEREAS, The vote to add "under God" to the Pledge of
- 22 Allegiance was a unanimous vote; and
- 23 WHEREAS, The first time the revised Pledge of Allegiance was
- 24 recited was on Flag Day, June 14, 1954; and
- 25 WHEREAS, It is the policy of the House of Representatives to
- 26 recognize and honor such an important date, which strengthens
- 27 the ties of history that bind us to our Judeo-Christian
- 28 heritage; therefore be it
- 29 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives, with due
- 30 reverence to the Almighty, recognize February 10, 2014, as the

- 1 60th anniversary of the addition of the words "under God" to the
- 2 Pledge of Allegiance of the United States.
