A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing November 19, 2015, as "American Made Matters Day" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Observed since 2013, "American Made Matters Day"
4 addresses the positive impact of American manufacturing on job
5 creation and enriching our local communities; and

6 WHEREAS, Investment in American-made products spurs the
7 United States economy, product safety and environmental
8 protection; and

9 WHEREAS, Investment in American-made products shapes the
10 future of our nation through innovation; and

11 WHEREAS, As part of "American Made Matters Day," consumers
12 are encouraged to buy at least one American-made product to show
13 their support of American manufacturing; and

1 WHEREAS, Consumers are further encouraged to buy American-
2 made products throughout the holiday shopping season; and

3 WHEREAS, The United States Bureau of Economic Analysis has
4 reported that every \$1 spent on American-made goods invests an
5 additional \$1.35 in the United States economy; and

6 WHEREAS, The Federal Advanced Manufacturing Portal has
7 revealed that for each manufacturing job there are 1.6
8 additional jobs in local service businesses; and

9 WHEREAS, Among high-tech manufacturing jobs, each job
10 generates up to five local service jobs; and

11 WHEREAS, High-tech manufacturing jobs promote demand in other
12 industries, including technology, supply chain management and
13 logistics; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize
15 November 19, 2015, as "American Made Matters Day" in
16 Pennsylvania.
