A RESOLUTION

- 1 Encouraging Amazon to choose a location in Pennsylvania as the future home of HQ2.
- 3 WHEREAS, On September 7, 2017, Amazon announced that it is
- 4 seeking to open a second company headquarters in North America
- 5 (Amazon HQ2) and will conduct a comprehensive search to decide
- 6 on the location; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The HQ2 campus will require up to 8 million square
- 8 feet of new space, may cost more than \$5 billion to build and
- 9 will employ up to 50,000 new full-time employees in the years
- 10 following commencement of operations; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Amazon issued a request for proposals for HQ2
- 12 highlighting specific requirements for an ideal site, including
- 13 a metropolitan area of at least 1 million people, greenfield or
- 14 infill space available to meet Amazon's space needs in multiple
- 15 phases, access to mass transit on site, close proximity to a

- 1 major international airport and a location able to attract and
- 2 retain strong technical talent; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The cities of Pennsylvania have commercial and
- 4 noncommercial real estate that is as affordable, if not more so,
- 5 than other cities in the United States, comparable in size and
- 6 density and its cost of living is below the national average;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's cities have growing millennial
- 9 populations with both Philadelphia and Pittsburgh ranking as
- 10 some of the fastest cities for millennial growth of any of the
- 11 nation's 10 largest cities; and
- 12 WHEREAS, With 164 four-year colleges out of 388 colleges,
- 13 community colleges and trade schools, Pennsylvania offers a
- 14 diverse pool of highly-skilled, experienced experts and young
- 15 professionals; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The University of Pennsylvania, Carnegie Mellon
- 17 University, Lehigh University, Villanova University, The
- 18 Pennsylvania State University, the University of Pittsburgh,
- 19 Drexel University, Temple University and Duquesne University are
- 20 all ranked nationally by U.S. News and World Report; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is an international gateway, perfectly
- 22 situated for business operations along the northeast corridor
- 23 and with close proximity to major cities such as Washington, DC,
- 24 and New York; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has a booming, diverse and highly
- 26 engaged startup ecosystem; and
- 27 WHEREAS, The cities of Pennsylvania have strong public
- 28 transit systems utilized by a wide variety of people; and
- 29 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has major international airports
- 30 located in Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, Harrisburg, the Lehigh

- 1 Valley and Wilkes-Barre/Scranton that connect its population to
- 2 all corners of the nation and world as well as a turnpike system
- 3 and convenient highway system to allow free and easy travel; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Amazon is interested in investing in an area that is
- 5 ripe for development, but also has existing buildings of at
- 6 least 500,000 square feet or a green site of approximately 100
- 7 acres; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has a wide selection of parcels, both
- 9 greenfield and infill, that would meet the criteria established
- 10 by Amazon; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's cities have a wide array of
- 12 historical attractions, with some playing a pivotal role in the
- 13 formation of American democracy, that have received national
- 14 recognition for their diversity, affordability and quality of
- 15 life with must-see amenities, including the art scene,
- 16 restaurants, walkability, bike-friendly streets, outdoor
- 17 recreation and public green spaces; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's cities have a longstanding commitment
- 19 to issues of sustainability and the environment; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's cities are known for their rich
- 21 history, vibrancy, affordability, job opportunities, diversity,
- 22 culture and nightlife; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's cities would make a perfect
- 24 destination for Amazon's HQ2; and
- 25 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania has everything that Amazon might need
- 26 to sustain and expand its growth and success; and
- 27 WHEREAS, The members of the Senate and the House of
- 28 Representatives, working alongside the administration of
- 29 Governor Tom Wolf, have shown their support and leadership in
- 30 encouraging business growth across this Commonwealth and would

- 1 work to support any large corporation, like Amazon, to locate
- 2 within Pennsylvania; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania stands ready to support and display all
- 4 that this Commonwealth has to offer to Amazon and looks forward
- 5 to the possibilities that a long and prosperous relationship
- 6 between Pennsylvania and Amazon can offer; therefore be it
- 7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
- 8 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania urge Amazon to choose one of
- 9 Pennsylvania's cities as the future home of HQ2 and stand ready
- 10 to work with Amazon to ensure success for both their business
- 11 and the people of Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be presented to Jeff
- 13 Bezos, Founder, Chairman, President and CEO of Amazon as a
- 14 sincere representation of the sentiments of the House of
- 15 Representatives.
