A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of November 18 through 22, 2019, as
2 "American Education Week" in Pennsylvania.

7 WHEREAS, A well-educated workforce is vital to the economic
8 well-being of the United States and this Commonwealth; and

9 WHEREAS, A good education leads to more skilled and higher
10 paying jobs; and

11 WHEREAS, "American Education Week" offers all Americans a
12 wonderful opportunity to celebrate public education and honor
13 individuals who are making a difference in ensuring that every
14 child receives a quality education; and

15 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has a strong and historic

1 tradition of commitment to public education and has been blessed
2 with the leadership of brilliant and innovative educators;
3 therefore be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
5 week of November 18 through 22, 2019, as "American Education
6 Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it further

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge educators,
8 parents and students throughout this Commonwealth to observe
9 "American Education Week" in Pennsylvania and use it to nurture
