A RESOLUTION

1 Amending the Ethical Conduct Rules of the House of
2 Representatives, further providing for Committee on Ethics.

3 RESOLVED, That the fifth paragraph of House Rule 3 E of the
4 Ethical Conduct Rules of the House of Representatives be amended
5 to read:

6 RULE 3 E

7 COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

8 * * *

9 The Committee shall compile, update and distribute a Members'
10 Handbook on Ethics for Members and House Employees on matters
11 regarding the ethical conduct of their legislative duties. Each
12 Member shall complete two hours of ethics education and training
13 and one hour of sexual harassment and discrimination in the
14 workplace education and training each legislative term. A Member
15 shall be excused from one hour of ethics education and training
16 for any full year the Member was absent due to illness, injury,
17 military service or any other permissible excuse under General
18 Operating Rule 64(a). The Committee shall be responsible for

1 planning and offering [ethics] the foregoing education and
2 training programs.
