A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the month of January 2020 as "National Mentoring 2 Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Mentoring is a proven, effective strategy that helps
- 4 children and young adults by matching them with caring and
- 5 responsible adults who can provide quidance and direction and
- 6 build their confidence; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Mentors build character, encourage success, lift
- 8 expectations and inspire young people to do their best, serving
- 9 as friends, role models, teachers and sources of stability and
- 10 support during a critical time in a child's life; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Research shows that mentoring has beneficial and
- 12 long-term effects on youths by increasing academic engagement
- 13 and decreasing the likelihood of substance abuse and other risky
- 14 behaviors; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Mentoring strengthens this Commonwealth's economic
- 16 and social well-being by helping young people fulfill their
- 17 potential while helping maintain healthy families and promoting

- 1 more vibrant communities; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Every day, residents of Pennsylvania make a profound
- 3 difference in the lives of young people by serving as mentors,
- 4 supported by many private and public sector organizations that
- 5 offer mentoring opportunities for youths; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The MENTOR Independence Region and the Mentoring
- 7 Partnership of Southwestern PA provide public, private and
- 8 nonprofit mentoring-focused organizations with the skills,
- 9 training and technical assistance necessary to help mentors
- 10 administer effective, high-quality mentoring practices to
- 11 children and youths in their communities; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Thousands of children in this Commonwealth are in
- 13 need of a caring adult mentor in their lives and closing this
- 14 mentoring gap requires more investment, partnerships and
- 15 volunteers ready to make a difference in a child's life and
- 16 community; and
- 17 WHEREAS, "National Mentoring Month" is an opportunity to
- 18 raise public awareness of the importance of mentoring, recognize
- 19 the dedicated individuals who serve as mentors and encourage
- 20 more residents to help build a brighter future for
- 21 Pennsylvania's youths through mentoring; therefore be it
- 22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 23 month of January 2020 as "National Mentoring Month" in
- 24 Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 25 RESOLVED, That the residents of this Commonwealth recognize
- 26 the importance of mentoring, look for opportunities to serve as
- 27 mentors in their communities and observe this "National
- 28 Mentoring Month" with appropriate activities and programs.
