1 2	Designating the week of February 18 through 25, 2017, as "FFA Week" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Future Farmers of America, now the National FFA
4	Organization (FFA), has grown from its agricultural beginnings
5	into a broad-spectrum leadership incubator; and
6	WHEREAS, The FFA creed expresses belief in the future of
7	agriculture "with a faith born not of words but of deeds"; and
8	WHEREAS, In accordance with the FFA motto, members serve
9	their chapter, community and country by cultivating friendships
10	and planting new ideas and seeds of hope wherever they go:
11	"learning to do, doing to learn, earning to live, living to
12	serve"; and

13 WHEREAS, The FFA State Theme is: "ACTIVATE: Purpose, Passion,

1 Potential"; and

2 WHEREAS, The FFA National Theme is: "Transform" with a tag 3 line of "Purpose to Action"; and

4 WHEREAS, The FFA in the 21st century welcomes young women and 5 young men with diverse backgrounds; and

6 WHEREAS, FFA membership has reached an all-time record high; 7 and

8 WHEREAS, More than 640,000 FFA members from 50 states, Puerto 9 Rico and the Virgin Islands are learning to be successful

10 leaders in production agriculture, agribusiness, agriscience and 11 nine other fields; and

12 WHEREAS, Many FFA members live far from working farms yet 13 have an interest in related fields such as food science, turf 14 management and horticulture; and

15 WHEREAS, FFA members who live in rural areas now represent 16 27% of the national organization; and

WHEREAS, Females comprise 37% of total membership and nearly 18 50% of all FFA officer teams; and

19 WHEREAS, More than 13,000 young people across this 20 Commonwealth continue to wear the traditional blue corduroy 21 jacket that distinguishes FFA members; and

22 WHEREAS, State FFA President Libby Baker-Mikesell of Port 23 Royal, Juniata County, represents today's diverse FFA; therefore 24 be it

25 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the 26 week of February 18 through 25, 2017, as "FFA Week" in 27 Pennsylvania and congratulate the members, advisers and parents 28 involved with this exemplary youth organization.
