A RESOLUTION

- Designating February 2, 2014, as "Rheumatoid Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Rheumatoid arthritis is a progressive inflammatory
- 4 disease causing damage to joint and organ tissues, resulting in
- 5 severe pain, frequent disability and increased mortality; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Rheumatoid arthritis, also known as Rheumatoid
- 7 disease, affects about 1% of the world's population, with 1.6 to
- 8 2 million Americans currently diagnosed; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Common symptoms of Rheumatoid disease include joint
- 10 pain, fatigue, fevers, stiffness, hoarseness and dry eyes; and
- 11 WHEREAS, There is a lack of awareness about Rheumatoid
- 12 disease since it is often presumed to be a type of arthritis,
- 13 leading to problems with disability accommodations, clinical
- 14 care, healthcare reimbursement and research funding; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The Mayo Clinic states that Rheumatoid arthritis
- 16 patients are twice as likely to experience silent heart attacks
- 17 and sudden cardiac deaths, and that the lifetime risk of the
- 18 disease is 3.6% for women and 1.7% for men; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Rheumatoid Awareness Day comes at the start of Heart
- 2 Disease Awareness month, underscoring the impact Rheumatoid
- 3 disease has on the heart prior to diagnosis; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The Rheumatoid Patient Foundation selected February
- 5 2, 2014, as their inaugural Rheumatoid Awareness Day in order to
- 6 increase public awareness of the disease; therefore be it
- 7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
- 8 February 2, 2014, as "Rheumatoid Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
