A RESOLUTION

1 2	Recognizing the year 2016 as "The Year to Cure Cancer" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, Cancer is the second leading cause of death in the
4	United States; and
5	WHEREAS, The American Cancer Society projects there will be
6	595,690 cancer deaths this year; and
7	WHEREAS, Cancer is the generic name for a subset of more than
8	100 diseases; and
9	WHEREAS, The body is made up of trillions of living cells;
10	healthy body cells divide to make new cells and die in an
11	orderly way; and
12	WHEREAS, During the early years of a person's life, normal
13	cells divide faster to allow the person to grow, and after the
14	person becomes an adult, most cells divide only to replace worn-

1 out or dying cells or to repair injuries; and

2 WHEREAS, Cancer starts when cells in a part of the body start 3 to grow out of control and, instead of dying, continue to grow 4 and form new, abnormal cells; and

5 WHEREAS, Cancer cells can invade other tissues when the 6 cancer cells get into the body's bloodstream or lymph vessels, a 7 process called metastasis; and

8 WHEREAS, The President and the Congress of the United States recently made a historic investment to fight cancer with a 9 10 strong appropriation to the National Institutes of Health; and WHEREAS, The Vice President of the United States has been 11 12 tasked by the President of the United States to lead the effort 13 to fight cancer in the President's last year in office; and 14 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth strongly supports this initiative and urges continued investment in cancer research within this 15 16 Commonwealth; therefore be it

17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the 18 year 2016 as "The Year to Cure Cancer" in Pennsylvania.
