- 9 WHEREAS, More than 81,000 nursing home residents are a living
- 10 testament to our history and a special treasure to our
- 11 Commonwealth; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The citizens of this Commonwealth residing in
- 13 nursing homes have contributed immeasurably to the heritage,
- 14 success and growth of our communities; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Nursing homes across this Commonwealth are holding
- 2 events in observance of Nursing Home Week guided by this year's
- 3 national theme of "Living the Aloha Spirit"; and
- WHEREAS, Nursing Home Week begins on Mother's Day, May 11,
- 5 and ends on May 17, 2014; therefore be it
