- Congratulating The Pennsylvania State University IFC/Panhellenic 1
- Dance Marathon (THON) for raising more than \$11 million for 2
- the Four Diamonds Fund at Penn State Hershey Children's
- Hospital to help fight pediatric cancer.
- 5 WHEREAS, THON is the commonly referred-to name for The
- Pennsylvania State University IFC/Panhellenic Dance Marathon,
- 7 the largest student-run philanthropy event in the world; and
- 8 WHEREAS, THON is a yearlong fundraising and awareness
- campaign to fight pediatric cancer, sustained by more than
- 16,500 volunteers who donate more than 5 million hours of their 10
- own time, that culminates in a 46-hour dance marathon in which 11
- 12 dancers are required to be continuously moving and not allowed
- 13 to sit or sleep; and
- WHEREAS, In 1977, THON partnered with the Four Diamonds Fund 14
- at Penn State Hershey Children's Hospital and chose Four 15

- 1 Diamonds as the sole beneficiary of THON's fundraising efforts;

- 3 WHEREAS, Four Diamonds offsets the cost of treatment that
- 4 insurance does not cover, including medical and emotional
- 5 support to ensure that all of a child's needs are met, and
- 6 supports the medical team that cares for the children; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Four Diamonds funds pediatric cancer research
- 8 through start-up grants and the Four Diamonds Pediatric Cancer
- 9 Research Center and cares directly for 500 children with cancer,
- 10 100 of which are children who have been newly diagnosed; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Since 1977, THON has raised more than \$168 million
- 12 to help provide emotional and financial support to the children,
- 13 families, researchers and staff of the Four Diamonds Fund; and
- WHEREAS, THON 2020 took place February 21 through 23, 2020,
- 15 at the Bryce Jordan Center at The Pennsylvania State University;
- 16 and
- 17 WHEREAS, THON 2020, Journey Together, revealed its total
- 18 fundraising amount of \$11,696,942.38; and
- 19 WHEREAS, THON has inspired similar events and organizations
- 20 across the United States, including at high schools and
- 21 institutions of higher education, and continues to encourage
- 22 students throughout the nation to volunteer and stay involved in
- 23 great charitable causes in their communities; and
- 24 WHEREAS, Since its introduction, THON has supported more than
- 25 4,000 children and families with childhood cancer and to this
- 26 day continues to enable research and improve treatments, cures
- 27 and benefits to ensure the cure of children with cancer around
- 28 the world; therefore be it

- 30 Pennsylvania State University IFC/Panhellenic Dance Marathon on
