A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of May 2018 as "Junior Achievement Month"
2 in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Junior Achievement is the world's largest

7 WHEREAS, More than 6,000 business, community and parent
8 volunteers touch the lives of more than 200,000 students in

10 systems in this Commonwealth with a message of hope and
11 prosperity for the future and prepare students to be the
12 workers, leaders and educated consumers of tomorrow; and
