A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of February 2015 as "Career and Technical  
2 Education Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, The observance of "Career and Technical Education  
4 Month" serves to increase public understanding and appreciation  
5 of the value of career and technical education; and

6 WHEREAS, Career and technical education must serve the needs  
7 of business and industry by delivering programs which meet  
8 national skill standards and offer recognized credentials; and

9 WHEREAS, This year's theme, "Recognizing Classroom  
10 Innovators," represents Pennsylvania's career and technical  
11 schools, comprehensive high schools and postsecondary  
12 institutions where teachers work to provide the academic and  
13 occupational technical skills that prepare our students for the  
14 emerging work force; and

1       WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Association of Career and Technical  
2 Administrators strives to promote excellence in career and  
3 technical education through leadership, advocacy and service;

5       WHEREAS, All citizens have the right to quality, affordable  
6 and accessible career and technical education in this  
7 Commonwealth; therefore be it

8       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the  
9 month of February 2015 as "Career and Technical Education Month"
