## A RESOLUTION

Designating April 7, 2018, as "Phi Mu Day" in Pennsylvania.
WHEREAS, Phi Mu was founded in 1852 at Wesleyan College in Macon, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, Phi Mu began as a Philomathean Society, which is a literary society; and

WHEREAS, Phi Mu is the second oldest sorority in the nation; and

WHEREAS, The mission of Phi $M u$ is to provide personal and academic development, service to others, commitment to excellence and lifelong friendship through a shared tradition; and

WHEREAS, Phi Mu's purpose is founded on the principles of love, honor and truth; and

WHEREAS, There have been more than 175,000 Phi Mu members and

WHEREAS, In 1999, Phi Mu became the first sorority to
establish "National Philanthropy Day"; and

WHEREAS, On April 7, 2018, the South Central Pennsylvania Alumnae Chapter and the Phi Kappa Collegiate Chapter of Phi Mu are cohosting "2018 Pennsylvania Phi Mu Day," at Muhlenberg College; and

WHEREAS, The event is a daylong celebration of Phi Mu and sisterhood by all members located in this Commonwealth and the surrounding states; and

WHEREAS, Activities include a meet and greet with the area chapters, a special ceremony, philanthropic projects for the Children's Miracle Network Hospitals and the Phi Mu Foundation, lunch and featured guest speakers from among Phi Mu's national officers; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate April 7, 2018, as "Phi Mu Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives congratulate the Phi Mu for its years of service to its community.
