A RESOLUTION

1 Designating April 7, 2018, as "Phi Mu Day" in Pennsylvania.

2 WHEREAS, Phi Mu was founded in 1852 at Wesleyan College in
3 Macon, Georgia; and

4 WHEREAS, Phi Mu began as a Philomathean Society, which is a
5 literary society; and

6 WHEREAS, Phi Mu is the second oldest sorority in the nation;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, The mission of Phi Mu is to provide personal and
9 academic development, service to others, commitment to
10 excellence and lifelong friendship through a shared tradition;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, Phi Mu's purpose is founded on the principles of
13 love, honor and truth; and

14 WHEREAS, There have been more than 175,000 Phi Mu members and
15 247 chapters; and

16 WHEREAS, In 1999, Phi Mu became the first sorority to

1 establish "National Philanthropy Day"; and

2 WHEREAS, On April 7, 2018, the South Central Pennsylvania
3 Alumnae Chapter and the Phi Kappa Collegiate Chapter of Phi Mu
4 are cohosting "2018 Pennsylvania Phi Mu Day," at Muhlenberg
5 College; and

6 WHEREAS, The event is a daylong celebration of Phi Mu and
7 sisterhood by all members located in this Commonwealth and the
8 surrounding states; and

9 WHEREAS, Activities include a meet and greet with the area
10 chapters, a special ceremony, philanthropic projects for the
11 Children's Miracle Network Hospitals and the Phi Mu Foundation,
12 lunch and featured guest speakers from among Phi Mu's national
13 officers; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate April
15 7, 2018, as "Phi Mu Day" in Pennsylvania; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives congratulate the
17 Phi Mu for its years of service to its community.
