A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of May 8 through 14, 2016, as "National Hospital Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals and health systems ensure
- 4 that health care services are available in this Commonwealth 24
- 5 hours a day, 7 days a week, providing acute inpatient care as
- 6 well as outpatient, emergency, behavioral health,
- 7 rehabilitation, long-term and home care services; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Specialized hospital care is provided by
- 9 Pennsylvania's 34 trauma centers, 6 burn centers and 14 critical
- 10 access hospitals that provide care for the most rural
- 11 populations in this Commonwealth; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania is home to six academic medical centers
- 13 and numerous teaching hospitals and medical schools that train
- 14 future health care providers and invest in critical health
- 15 research; and

- 1 WHEREAS, "National Hospital Week" dates back to 1921, in
- 2 Chicago, as an event to build trust during the Spanish influenza
- 3 outbreak; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The celebration serves as a reminder that hospitals
- 5 are foundations of the communities that built them and serve
- 6 people from all walks of life in every community; and
- 7 WHEREAS, "National Hospital Week" celebrates hospitals and
- 8 the men and women who support the health of their communities
- 9 through dedication and compassionate care; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals today are multidimensional
- 11 organizations that partner with many other organizations in
- 12 their communities to offer care with a focus on population
- 13 health, prevention and wellness; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals provide free care to those
- 15 who have no health care insurance or inadequate insurance
- 16 coverage, providing more than \$1 billion in uncompensated care
- 17 annually; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania hospitals contributed \$111 billion to
- 19 this Commonwealth's economy during 2014; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Hospitals are among the leading employers in their
- 21 communities, providing nearly 591,000 total jobs, directly and
- 22 indirectly; therefore be it
- 23 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize May 8
- 24 through 14, 2016, as "National Hospital Week" in Pennsylvania;
- 25 and be it further
- 26 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge its members
- 27 to visit the hospitals in their communities to learn about the
- 28 innovative, quality care and services that are improving the
- 29 health and quality of life for residents of this Commonwealth.
