7 boot makers, weavers, tailors, innkeepers, a blacksmith, a
8 locksmith and a justice of the peace; and

9 WHEREAS, Throughout the years, the population of Dover
10 Borough has continued to grow, reaching approximately 2,000
11 residents in 2014; and

12 WHEREAS, Dover is a suburb of the city of York, York County,
13 and is a quaint residential community; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commemorate Dover
15 Borough on the 250th anniversary of its founding and the 150th

1 anniversary of its incorporation and congratulate Dover Borough
2 on its rich history.
